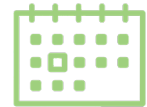
Mode

Is this course for me?

This course will provide you with the skills necessary to become an effective and highly valued employee in an Outside of School Hours Care service. This includes Before and After School Care and Vacation Care for school aged children.

This course is an essential stepping stone to a meaningful career for people with a natural affinity and interest in the development and education of children.

This course encompasses the development of School Aged Children, the importance of Educator and family partnerships, essential knowledge around first aid and develops a sound knowledge of the major curriculum learning areas and much more. It will provide you with the practical experience and theoretical knowledge required in an School Aged Education and Care setting.

Entry Requirements

There are no set pre-requisites for this qualification however; you must show:

- A satisfactory level of language and literacy skills, which will be established at the time of enrolment
- A genuine desire to work in the School Aged Education and Care profession
- Immunisation record and current Influenza vaccine
