Is this course for me?

Community services is a great industry to join if you have a passion for helping others. Person-centred support is needed to assist a range of people in day-to-day tasks.

This certificate will teach you how to listen to and understand people's problems, background and circumstances, and to assist them within the areas they need help, including social, emotional and physical wellbeing. You will also learn to deal with and implement support systems and develop plans which will address your clients' immediate and long term needs, including responding to critical situations including children at risk.

Entry Requirements

There are no set pre-requisites for this qualification however you must show:

- A satisfactory level of language and literacy skills, which will be established at the time of enrolment
- A genuine desire to work in the Early Childhood Education and Care profession
- Working With Children Check is a part of the practical requirements and immunisation record may be required

Tuition Fees

From 1st January 2023 this course is a part of the Free in '23 program. The course fees for this course will be 100% subsidised by WA state government for eligible students in 2023. Places are limited.

Eligibility:

- an Australian citizen; or
- a permanent visa holder or holder of visa subclass 309, 444, 785, 790 or 820;
- a dependent or spouse of the primary holder of a vissubclass 457: or
- a Bridging Visa E holder (subclasses 050 and 051) and you have made a valid application for a visa of subclass 785 or 790.
- visa subclasses 449 and 786, which are currently used for Ukraine and Afghan nationals;
- secondary holders (spouses and dependents) of Temporary Skill Shortage visa (subclass 482)
- bridging visas A, B, C and E where holders have work rights and have made a valid application for a Permanen Protection Visa (subclass 866)

Eligible Period: 1st January 2023 – 31st December 2023
